How does USE Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does USE Credit Union collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account or deposit money pay your bills or use your credit or debit card apply for financing We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus,
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 affiliates, or other companies. Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you
	State law and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. USE Credit Union does not share with our affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. USE Credit Union does not share with our nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.
